Archbishop Aquila has chosen to make the following temporary precautions for celebrating Mass mandatory for all parishes and churches in the Archdiocese of Denver. For more information visit archden.org/coronavirus.

- The Holy Water will be removed from the hand-fonts.
- There will be No Handholding during the Lord's Prayer.
- It is highly recommended that Holy Communion only be distributed in the hand.
- ALL Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion will sanitize their hands prior to distributing Communion.
- Priests will assure the faithful they are not obliged to attend Mass if they are sick and that staying home can be an act of charity towards their fellow parishioners.

PLEASE REFRAIN from bringing surplus prayer cards, novenas, religious articles, rosaries and metals into the Church and leaving at the Church doors. We DO NOT have a NEED for such items.
